

KINDLE FIRE – ADDING THE NOOK APP

Proceed at your own risk*

1. Using the Kindle Fire, visit the App store and download the free ES File Explorer<<http://www.amazon.com/ES-Mobile-File-Explorer/dp/B008K6HN8I>>. You MIGHT be able to skip this step.
2. On the Kindle Fire >> Settings >> Device >> Turn on "Allow Installation of Applications from Unknown Sources." See screenshots here<<http://google.about.com/od/kindlefire/ss/How-To-Install-Nook-And-Kobo-Apps-On-Your-Kindle-Fire.htm#step-heading>>.
3. Visit the mobile site of GetJar using the default browser on the Kindle Fire, search for Nook, and install the app. <http://m.getjar.mobi>
