## TRINITARIAN CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH

As we approach this Easter season, let us recall **Luke 24:1-8**, “on the first day of the week, at early dawn, they went to the tomb, taking the spices they had prepared. 2 And they found the stone rolled away from the tomb, 3 but when they went in they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. 4 While they were perplexed about this, behold, two men stood by them in dazzling apparel. 5 And as they were frightened and bowed their faces to the ground, the men said to them, “Why do you seek the living among the dead? 6 He is not here, but has risen. Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee, 7 that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men and be crucified and on the third day rise.” 8 And they remembered his words.”

We choose to remember his words “because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved.” **Romans 10:9-10**

On Palm Sunday, April 2nd, we will remember Jesus’ triumphal entry into Jerusalem. We will recall the contrast of the people shouting “Hosanna!” and worshipping Jesus as they laid palm branches out for Him to the tragedy of their betrayal only days later as they gave Him up to be crucified.

On Good Friday, April 7th, the First Baptist Church of Troy will join with us for a Good Friday service to be held in the TCC sanctuary at 7:00 p.m. to remember and reflect on the sacrifice made by Jesus Christ on the cross. This service will be one of remembrance and prayer. There will be a reading of the crucifixion narrative followed by a message. The service will conclude with the partaking of Holy Communion.

On Easter Sunday, April 9th, our hearts will turn to joy as we celebrate Jesus’ resurrection and the hope that we now have in our risen Savior! Easter morning will begin at 7:00

a.m. with a Sunrise Service. Following the service, a full breakfast will be served in the Fellowship Hall. At 9:30 a.m., the Easter Celebration service will commence with joyous music and a sermon about the glorious hope of Jesus’ triumphant resurrection. Hallelujah – He has risen!



## FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH

Pastor Donn is continuing to teach through the book of John, the fourth book in the New Testament. It is amazing what we are learning! But on Easter Sunday morning our focus will be on Easter, Jesus' death and burial and **RESURRECTION!** It is one thing to know that He died on the cross, shedding His blood for our sin, and was buried in a tomb. However it is absolutely amazing that we can know He did not stay dead in that tomb but was resurrected from the grave which means He totally conquered sin, death and Hell! Hallelujah!! What a Savior! One author, Karen Huang, puts it this way, "I'd believed that if I made mistakes, I wouldn't be loved. But Scripture says God already loved me even when my sinful nature defined me as one who'd forever fail Him. Jesus released me from the penalty of being a sinner and took on my sin (I Corinthians 5:21)." This author goes on to say, "Ephesians 1:7 says, [Christ] purchased our freedom with the blood of his Son and forgave our sins"...The Greek word translated "purchased our freedom" means a release brought about by payment of a ransom. This is the hope-filled message of Easter!"

We will celebrate Easter beginning with the combined Good Friday Service at the Trinitarian Congregational Church. On Easter morning we invite you to our Easter breakfast in our fellowship hall at First Baptist Church at 9am followed by our Easter morning service in our sanctuary at 10:30am. **Everyone is welcome!**

Knowing Christ as Savior and having fellowship with others of like faith is very important! For that reason, we invite those who do not already have a "home church" to visit First Baptist Church of Troy. We are located on Route 12 North of the common. Our Sunday morning service is at 10:30am. During that time, we focus on four things: singing hymns and songs in praise to the Lord, praying for one another, the teaching of God's Word, and fellowship with one another.

We meet for an informal time of prayer at the church on Tuesday evenings at 7pm. All are welcome to come as we share praises and prayer requests and discuss any questions concerning the previous Sunday's message. It is a great time to encourage one another.


